

2019 MQHYA Letter of Intent – NYATT TEAM

NYATT Deadline – Completed packet received at MQHA by June 15

This letter will serve as notice to the MQHYA, of the intent of the undersigned to participate in the National Youth Association Team Tournament (NYATT) representing the Michigan Quarter Horse Association or the Michigan Snaffle Bit Association. This letter will only apply to one American Quarter Horse. The Youth that is referred to in this letter agrees to and understands the following:

1. The Youth must be a member in good standing of MQHA and AQHA.
2. The Youth will participate in a minimum two (2) MQHYA Board Meetings within the qualifying period.
3. MQHA will cover the cost of AQHA and NSBA entries. The Youth will pay all additional fees assessed to MQHA by OQHA.
4. **The items listed below must be fulfilled and sent in a completed packet to be considered for a spot on the NYATT team. If items are sent electronically, please put “NYATT Letter of Intent, Child’s Name” on the subject line (mqha@hotmail.com).**
 - a. The completed Letter of Intent.
 - b. A \$250 team fee (refundable if not selected for a MQHA supported team).
 - c. A biography (150 words or fewer) containing pertinent information for publication, submitted in Word via email.
 - d. A photograph of good quality. If emailed, must be a good resolution attachment.
 - e. The Youth (not a substitute) must provide volunteer hours. There must be at least ten (10) total volunteer hours, with at least five (5) of the hours volunteered to MQHA. The remaining five (5) hours may be documented community service hours. In the case of a Youth who has participated on the Youth World Show Team, these hours will be reduced to two (2) hours volunteered to MQHA. If the service hours are not completed, MQHA will require a payment of \$50 per hour for each hour not fulfilled. Sponsorships acquired prior to the NYATT entries being sent in, may be used to offset the service hours. See advisor for more information. **This money will go to offset team costs and help with team fundraising.**
5. The Youth understands that there may be fundraisers to offset the cost of these trips. Monthly MQHYA meetings may include information on possible fundraisers.
6. For the NYATT, Youth will be chosen based on their point standings from July 15 through the Harbor Classic from all age youth or 14-18 youth classes. The best ten (10) judges’ scores will be used to tabulate the qualifying points. Any out of state youth must show at four of the MQHA approved circuits offered during the qualifying period and have an approved AQHA hardship on file with MQHA, to be considered for a position on the team. Two (2) youth will be chosen for each class offered.
7. To be fair to all Youth involved, if a Youth accepts a position on a team and does not show in their class without prior written approval of the team Advisor, they will not be eligible for participation on that team the following year.
8. If a class is not filled in the above manner, the position will be offered first to any MQHYA Board/Committee member in good standing with their MQHYA Board obligations fulfilled and who has shown at four (4) MQHA approved circuits in the desired class, within the past fifteen (15) months. Any remaining slots will then be offered to the general MQHYA membership.
9. If a Youth is asked to fill any open position for NYATT, they are required to provide items #3 and #4a, 4b, 4c and 4d above.
10. The Youth agrees to abide by all team rules supplied to them in advance of these shows.
11. The Youth Advisor and the Selection Committee may waive any of the requirements above for any special conditions that may arise from a Youth participant, provided that the exception is approved by both the MQHYA and MQHA Board of Directors. The death or disability of a horse may be considered an exception.
