

# Michigan Quarter Horse Futurity/GLC Exhibitors

The change in locations to Mason (Ingham County Fairgrounds) comes with other changes. Please take the time to review this!

- This Fairgrounds has limited 50 amp camping.
- This Fairgrounds has water at about 90 camping sites. We are also trying to add water to 20 additional sites. We have about 175 campsites reserved. If you can get along without a water hook up, please let us know so we can offer it to someone who needs it.
- Please fill your water tanks just in case.
- Please bring as much hose as you have, especially if you are in the south campground because water may need to come from a distance similar to how it was at Michigan State a number of years ago.
- Some of the camp sites where the power is located are not level but you can solve that problem by having extra cord.
- We will be posting a stall chart on Monday afternoon. If you are stalled in the south part of the fairgrounds, we will make every effort to have camping near where your horses are. The same can be said with the north part of the fairgrounds.
- Once you come in and unload, we will help to place people into the campground by assigned areas. If you want to be next to someone, please plan to coordinate so we can park you together in your assigned area (provided everyone has a reservation).
- There will be no reserving of spots at this show by exhibitors. If you park in a spot and you did not check in with our staff, you will be asked to move.
- There are no parking zones around buildings. If you park in one of those areas, you will be towed without warning.
- There is plenty of parking across the street from the fairgrounds for anyone who is spectating or not parked in front of their camper. All horse trailers that are not used for camping will need to be parked on the West end of the fairgrounds. There is plenty of space as well as an overflow across the street. We ask that you unhook any pull behind trailers. There is not room on the campgrounds for these.
