Qualifications for High Point Awards:

- Open, Youth, Amateur, Select and Small Fry must show in corresponding halter or performance halter class to be eligible for High Point Awards
- · Halter points are not included for Rookie, Level 1 and W/T Amateur or W/T Youth events.
- · All divisions must show in at least three events to be eligible. (i.e. WP, Showmanship and HUS)
- · Green classes are not included in the open high point calculations.
- · Ranch High Point includes: Ranch Trail, Ranch Riding, Reining, and Working Western Rail.

MQHA Small Fry (ASTM/ SEI Helmet Required)

- Exhibitors 9 & under walk trot only.
- One horse, one exhibitor, per class. The exhibitor may show a different horse in each discipline but only one horse in a class.

Lead Line (ASTM/ SEI Helmet Required)

- · Participants in Lead Line will be assisted by a handler that is at least 18 years old.
- Exhibitors will not be placed in this class.
- · Participants in Intermediate Lead Line will not be assisted by a handler but must have a side walker at least 18 years old. They may be asked to perform a walk only pattern.
