2024 AQHA Leveling Point Ranges:

Now Available Online

Owners and exhibitors can compare their show record for an approximation of the levels they will be eligible for in the 2024 show season.

Points earned from November 1, 2019, through October 31, 2023*, will be used to determine 2024 level eligibility. Awards and money earned in other organizations are also taken into consideration for level eligibility; refer to Rule SHW245.3.

How Levels Are Determined

**The three-year leveling point ranges will continue to exclude 2020 from the equation to determine the point thresholds, in accordance with a decision made by the AQHA Show Committee to limit the impacts of the pandemic.*
