The Michigan Quarter Horse Association is once again seeking nominations for the MQHA Hall of Fame. This program honors individuals and horses who have made a significant contribution to MQHA and have had an impact on the Quarter Horse breed. The Hall of Fame award serves as a lasting tribute to outstanding individuals in the Quarter Horse industry. Nominees may be living or dead, and must have been a permanent resident of Michigan for at least five years, or owned by a Michigan resident for at least five years. Horses nominated must not be showing, standing stud or taking remuneration of any kind. Hall of Fame recipients will be inducted at the annual Michigan Quarter Horse Awards Banquet and Convention held in January each year. Please see the MQHA website or contact the MQHA office for a list of prior inductees.

All Hall of Fame nominations will be reviewed by the nomination committee. If your nomination is selected, you will be contacted by the MQHA office or a member of the Hall of Fame committee. Any submissions are kept on file for future consideration.
